Students of the CPA will be taught a variety of different topics such as:

- Laws of Arrest
- Search and Seizure
- Use of Force
- CPR
- Domestic Violence
- Narcotics and Homicide
- Terrorism Awareness
- Gang Activity



Participants have the opportunity to go on a ride along with a Patrol Officer. Students get to ask questions and experience firsthand what a patrol officer does, and what a patrol officer might have to do any given day.

Participants will also have the opportunity to become certified in American Heart Association CPR. Students will learn both Adult CPR and AED use.

Upon finishing this program, students will attend a formal graduation and be presented with a certificate of completion. All graduates are eligible to become members of the SCCA Alumni Associations.
